WORK & CAREER READINESS

The JA Career Ignite is an interactive in-person experience for high school students that connects them to post-secondary opportunities: Employment, Enrollment, Enlistment, and Entrepreneurship.

Utilizing the proven structure of JA JobSpark® and JA Career Ignite, this career fair will help students navigate their next steps in life by bringing together information about colleges, careers, military service, and entrepreneurship opportunities in northern Indiana. Students will explore their future pathways to prepare for next steps towards future career goals.

PATHWAYS

Employment: Students have direct access to local employers who are looking to hire high school students immediately following graduation. Employers share applications for open positions, internships, and job shadow opportunities. The event will provide the opportunity for onsite interviews.

Enrollment: Students explore what it takes to enroll and pay for a college or university in addition to learning about trade programs and certification courses for continued education.

Enlistment: Students discover enlistment opportunities in one of the branches of the US military.

Entrepreneurship: Students will have the opportunity to network with local entrepreneurs to guide them towards next steps in their entrepreneurial ventures.
